Crystal AirCruises will deliver bespoke, exclusive air and land experiences with Crystal Skye, the world's most spacious and only twin aisle private aircraft

Hong Kong, 20 July 2017 – Yesterday, Genting Hong Kong Limited, a leading global leisure corporation, officially launched its inaugural itinerary for Crystal Skye for the Asia Pacific region. Crystal Skye's first itinerary in Asia will be a dynamic, comprehensive expedition showcasing destinations both fascinating and exotic. Designed to entice even the savviest of explorers, the first chartered journey in Asia will accommodate 86 guests, ushering in a new standard of bespoke travel experiences in the region. Genting Hong Kong is managing the charter under the Crystal brand in the region. Crystal Skye will then be available for charters and other special interest AirCruises throughout the world.

Crystal will take delivery of Crystal Skye on August 1 from Greenpoint Technologies in Washington and will be christened on August 12 during the Virtuoso Week in Las Vegas.

Departing from Hong Kong or Macau on 30 September 2017, Crystal Skye will whisk guests away on an eight-night voyage to two locales famed for their natural wonder and beauty, including:

- Nairobi, Kenya: To discover the spectacular landscapes of Maasai Mara National Reserve, with its rolling hills bordering Kenya and Tanzania, and to encounter the continent's "Big 5" – lions, elephants, rhinoceros, leopards and water buffalo – during a safari through the wilds of Africa
- Tahiti, French Polynesia: For sunbathing on black sandy beaches at Point Venus, Tahiti's northernmost extremity, or dive deep down around the islands and be amazed by the clear waters, bright coral and density of large marine life

The all-inclusive price encompasses the best hotels and accommodations in Kenya and Tahiti, unique cuisine, all beverages, entertainment, private plane transfers and the exclusive service of the world’s first “Air Butlers” during the journey.

The world’s largest and most luxuriously spacious private tour jet, Crystal Skye can also be chartered for 1 to 28 nights on iconic global journeys for birthday or anniversary celebrations, themed group journeys or other events where up to 86 guests can travel together in the same lavish aircraft. Crystal Skye offers more inclusive, exclusive options to create customized itineraries than any other private jet experience.

Guests can create custom journeys from a selection of diverse points around the globe, ranging from the cosmopolitan (London and New York City), to the exotic (Iguaçu Falls, Argentina and Tashkent, Uzbekistan), to the scenic (Rio de Janeiro and Buenos Aires), and a host of other dazzling destinations. A key feature of the aircraft will be its ability to fly non-stop for 19 hours, longer than any commercial air flight, and connect any two points on the opposite side of the earth – surpassing the current longest route from Singapore to New York at 16-17 hours.

The only twin-aisle aircraft private plane, Crystal Skye is larger and newer than any global private jet tour travel option and is appointed with features rarely found in even the most luxurious private plane. She has the highest crew to passenger ratio of any twin-aisle aircraft, is capable of journeys that stretch to the far reaches of the earth, and offers curated experiences tailored to each traveler’s preferences. Cuisine will be prepared by an executive chef in two state-of-the-art galleys, and paired with an elegant premium wine list from the Crystal Skye Cellar.

Guests will also enjoy comforts and conveniences including Bose® Noise Cancelling headphones, Apple® iPads, complimentary global WiFi, interactive TVs with on-demand programming and music library, individual USB ports and power outlets, and a live cockpit-to-



ground listening channel. Additionally, spacious lavatories appointed with luxury amenities, like a private jet, offer more than the comforts of home during the global journeys.

On land, the choice of four interchangeable Destination Experiences in each destination will offer as many as seven unique options on any given day. To ensure an unsurpassed level of comfort and luxury, accommodations will include the finest hotels, resorts, eco-villages and safari lodges with all transfers and privileged access to sites and attractions included. Culinary experiences at critically acclaimed restaurants, including Michelin- and Gault et Millau-rated favorites will also be de rigueur.
